POLICE MAKE ARRESTS IN MALLOVE HOMICIDE

On May 14, 2004, at 10:53pm, members of the Norwich Police Patrol Division were led to the body of Dr. Eugene F. Mallove to the rear of 119 Salem Tpke., Norwich, Connecticut. The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner in Farmington, Connecticut subsequently ruled the manner of death a Homicide.

On April 1, 2010 at 1:30 pm, Detectives arrested the following individual for the murder of Dr. Eugene F. Mallove of Pembroke, New Hampshire.

The arrest is a result of an extensive, nearly six year, investigation conducted by the Norwich Police Department in conjunction with the New London County State's Attorney's Office, the Connecticut State Police, and the Chief State's Attorney's Office in Rocky Hill.

Also assisting in the arrest phase was a special arrest team from the Norwich Police Department. Social Workers from the Department of Children and Families took the minor children of both of the accused into protective custody.

Schaffer was developed as a person of interest early in the investigation however, until recently there was insufficient evidence to support his arrest. In November of 2008 a joint investigative task force was formed with the Norwich Police Department, New London County State's Attorney's Office, the Connecticut State Police, and the Chief State's Attorney's.

At that time Detectives James Curtis (NPD) and Terence McFadden (CSP) were assigned to the investigation fulltime. As the case continued to expand and additional leads were developed, Sgt. Corey Poore (NPD) was added as an additional fulltime resource to the investigative team.

In February 2009 a \$50,000 Governor's reward was authorized and in April of 2009, with the assistance of the Mallove family and the CBS Outdoor Advertising Agency, a billboard advertising campaign was launched seeking information into this brutal homicide.

Subsequently, additional new evidence was developed by Detective James Curtis and Sgt. Corey Poore, including statements, led to the arrest warrants being issued.

Foster was arrested by warrant issued by the New London State's Attorney's Officer Part "A" at 70 Huntington Street, New London, CT. A \$2,500,000 bond was set on the arrest warrant by the court. Foster will be presented in Norwich Superior Court on April 5, 2010.

Schaffer was arrested by warrant issued by the New London State's Attorney's Officer Part "A" at 70 Huntington Street, New London, CT. A \$10,000,000 bond was set on the arrest warrant by the court. Schaffer will be presented in Norwich Superior Court on April 5, 2010.

The investigation remains open and ongoing. Further arrests are anticipated in this case, therefore no further details of the investigation can be released at this time.
